### Poster Presentations

Dear poster presenters,

Please put up your poster directly upon your arrival after visiting the registration desk, where you will be provided with your assigned poster number and tape to attach your poster to the poster board. Please only use the provided tape to attach your poster to the board.

Your poster should not exceed the following format (width x height): 90 x 120 cm.

The poster sessions will take place Wednesday (17:30-19:30) and Thursday afternoon (16:30-18:30) in a relaxed atmosphere with drinks in the assembly hall "Aula" on the first floor in the castle (Schloss Hohenheim). In order to allow insightful discussions of your posters, we will not have chaired poster presentations, but rather invite everyone to informally view and discuss the posters with you during the poster sessions.

To also give you the opportunity to view and discuss posters with your fellow presenters, we kindly ask you to stay with your poster for the first 90 minutes of the poster sessions and to view the other posters during the remaining 30 minutes of each poster session.

It may be useful to also bring the video(s) as individual file(s) in case embedding does not work properly. The computers in the lecture halls will be connected to the internet, but please do not rely on a working internet connection for your talk as unforeseen events may limit the availability of the internet connection.

Please bring your presentation to the media center (see castle floor plan on the program website) in the Blue Room (Blauer Saal) on the morning of your session, where you will be able to test run your presentation on a laptop with the same configuration as the computers in the lecture hall.
